

Hoff Family Arts Scholarship Fund Program Guidelines

Pottawattamie Arts, Culture and Entertainment (PACE) is dedicated to helping youth within Council Bluffs and the surrounding areas to attend and to succeed in Arts education.

The *Mission* of PACE is to enrich, inspire, and energize our community through supporting arts, culture, and connections.

The *Vision* of PACE is to cultivate a stronger community where art and culture thrive.

The **Purpose** of the **Hoff Family Arts Scholarship Fund** is to provide scholarships to deserving high school graduating seniors intending to pursue a course of study within Art, Music, Theater, Dance or Culinary at a two-year or four-year educational institution, certificate program, or seeking professional training.

For 2023, the Hoff Family Arts & Culture Performing Arts Scholarship Fund's award ceiling is \$10,000, and the individual maximum award is \$5,000. PACE will award approximately 2 scholarships. NOTE: Scholarship funds will be awarded to the student upon evidence of registration in an accredited higher educational institution or training program.

Criteria and eligibility (Hoff Family Arts & Culture Performing Arts Scholarship Fund applicants)

- 1. Applicant must attend high school within Omaha-Council Bluffs, NE-IA Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA).
- 2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
- 3. Applicant must have a desired college major or minor in Art, Music, Theater, Dance or Culinary or is seeking professional training in one or more of these areas.
- 4. Applicant must demonstrate community involvement and desire to continue their education.
- 5. Applicants may not be related to any PACE Board of Directors, PACE staff, or the Hoff Family.
- 6. Applicants must have at least 40 hours of service or participation in classes, productions, or volunteer work at the Hoff Family Arts & Culture Center and/or with PACE Partner organizations (PACE, Chanticleer Community Theater, Kanesville Symphony Orchestra, American Midwest Ballet, and Kitchen Council.)

General Instructions

- 1. DEADLINE for scholarship applications is **Friday March 31, 2023, 5:00 p.m.** (no exceptions).
- 2. Refer to application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed (i.e., reference forms, evidence of GPA, etc.) Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 3. If any question does not apply to you in this application, please put N/A in the space.
- 4. Type or print legibly. Illegible applications will not be considered.
- 5. You will be notified by mail in March regarding the status of your application.
- 6. You may be requested to participate in Scholarship Showcase on Friday April 28th, 2023.

Applicant Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

- 1. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly)
- 2. Letter of application addressed to the Scholarship Committee. The letter should contain a brief explanation about yourself and your plans (college, university, conservatory and/or professional training program, major/minor/focus and anticipated start date). Letter should not exceed one (1) page.



- 3. Two (2) letters of recommendations from choice of high school teachers, administrators, counselors, employers, or PACE Partner, with significant knowledge of applicant's experience and involvement.
- 4. An official and recent high school transcript with cumulative grade point average.
- 5. Personal Essay with educational and professional goals and objectives. Essay must be at least 1-2 typed pages, double-spaced, 12 pt., Arial font. Essay shall contain no grammatical errors.
- 6. Document at least 40 hours of service or participation in classes, productions, or volunteer work at the Hoff Family Arts & Culture Center or with PACE Partner organizations including: PACE, Chanticleer Community Theater, Kanesville Symphony Orchestra, American Midwest Ballet and Kitchen Council. Examples might include:
 - a. Being part of the cast or crew of a Chanticleer production.
 - b. Taking dance lessons from American Midwest Ballet.
 - c. Taking a cooking or art class with PACE.
 - d. Volunteering in the box office or gallery as a Junior PACE Ambassador.
 - e. Attending a Chanticleer, Kanesville Symphony, or American Midwest Ballet show.
 - f. Being a teacher's assistant or chef's assistant during an art or culinary class.
 - g. Participating in a Kitchen Council educational event, like Food Startup 101.
- 7. (Optional) Submit a portfolio (up to five images and/or two video samples) in the area that represents your strength in the arts and the art form you are most likely to pursue in the arts. Email info@paceartsiowa.org, and a Google Drive link will be shared with you for uploading of the portfolio. Items must be arranged chronologically and captioned as follows: title, year, media, dimensions (if needed).
- 8. (Optional) The scholarship committee may request participation in a "Scholarship Showcase" where applicants and awardees are invited to perform, give presentations, or exhibit their work. These performances and exhibitions will be free and open to the public so others can learn more about the Hoff Center's programs and celebrate the outstanding and talented young adults in Council Bluffs and the surrounding areas.
